NO EXCEPTIONS TO THE DEADLINE! PLEASE PLAN AHEAD SO A YOUTH IS NOT DISAPPOINTED!

Financial assistance provided by the Texas Southwest Council are to be considered to be one-half (1/2) or less of the early bird fee. Texas Southwest Council recognizes the advantage to youth participating in Council programs and wants to aid legitimate need cases. It does not, however, want to assume the total responsibility; the council does want to assist the family, the unit and/or the charter partner.

1. Camperships are available ONLY to youth members who are registered members of the Texas Southwest Council, Boy Scouts of America, for at least three (3) months prior to the campership deadline.
2. It must be understood that all other sources of financial help have been exhausted including the youth's own earning power, his family, his unit, and the chartered partner's resources
3. The campership supports are limited to Texas Southwest Council, BSA camps and activities.
4. Applications must be submitted in writing will ALL requested information completed by the member's unit leader to the council service center. NO CAMBERSHIP APPLICATION WILL BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT THE CERTIFICATION SIGNATURE OF THE UNIT LEADER.
5. The VP of Program, Council Camping/Training Chair and Staff Advisor will have final approval of all Campership Applications
